If you have any of these conditions in your home the next step is to get a professional mold inspection



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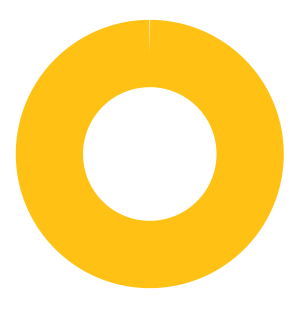
Professional Remediation

It is important to use proper enclosures, air movers, and remediation practices. This will ensure you protect your property and your family.

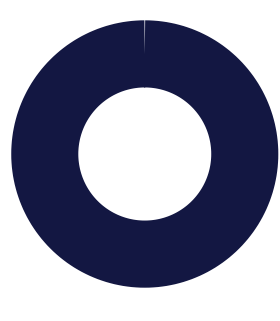
Below is SFW Construction's 3 step process -
